

Monoski 2014 European Championship Rules and Regulations

Article 1 :

The Monoski European Championship, named "LE MONDIAL DE MONOSKI" (Monoski Worldcup) is organised by the French Monoski Association "Association Française de Monoski" and by the "Bootleggers" on January 31 and February 1 and 2, 2014, in the resort "Les Sept Laux". This event includes three races : a slalom with two runs , KL and a derby counting for the ranking of the best European monoskiier.

Article 2 : Warning on security and fitness

2.1 The event "LE MONDIAL DE MONOSKI" is open to anybody in excellent health condition and well-trained. Every competitor must fully master skiing and snow gliding techniques.

2.2 For evident safety and ethical reasons, the Organiser may refuse any competitor suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

2.3 The competition slopes of the "MONDIAL DE MONOSKI" are strictly reserved for the registered competitors. They will be accessible only during official opening hours, under the Starter's control.

2.4 Disclaimer - The Organiser cannot be held liable or accept liability for any accident that may occur to competitors or any sequels that might follow, damage or injury caused by another participant or to a third party, and loss or theft of personal belongings.

Article 3 : Individual mandatory safety equipment

3.1 Any competitor registered in the races of the "MONDIAL DE MONOSKI" not equipped with the following safety gear shall not be allowed to participate :

1. A ski approved helmet
2. Bib with the competitor's number delivered by the Organiser

3.2 A briefing session will take place before each race ; attendance is compulsory.

3.3 Pre-inspection of the derby itinerary is highly recommended. This inspection is free and under the sole responsibility of the competitor.

Article 4 : Technical equipment

For the "MONDIAL DE MONOSKI" races, only monoskis are admitted in the competition.

Article 5 : Registration & fees

5.1 Application is registered on reception of the completed and signed official registration form along with payment of the registration fee.

Registration fee :

Upon presentation of their member card, the members of Association Française de Monoski benefit from a 50% discount on skipasses ; the Saturday evening dinner is offered.

5.2 No registration will be made by phone.

5.3 For the races of the "MONDIAL DE MONOSKI", it is recommended to join to the registration form a medical certificate allowing the practice of monoski, dating back to no more than 12 months.

5.4 The registration includes : a). the right to take part in the races ; b). the official bib ; c). the mid-day barbecue and the Saturday evening dinner ; d). a discount on skipasses ; e). participation in the draw organised on Saturday night.

Article 6 : Insurance

6.1 The "Association Française de Monoski" has purchased a public liability organiser insurance from DIOT Montagne in Bourg St Maurice, contract n° AH 147557.

6.2 All competitors are responsible for obtaining their own adequate public liability insurance and must be able to show proof of the respective insurance coverage at any time on request.

Article 7 : Cancellation

The Race Committee have a delegation at any moment from the Organiser to amend the present rules and regulations, or delay or cancel the event, especially if they believe that the weather or instability of the snow cover could reduce safety.

Article 8 : Ranking for the European monoski Championship

Each competitor receives a number of points related to the number of participants in the race.

Ex : For 100 competitors, the first in rank will receive 100 points ; the second 99 points, etc.

For the slalom race and KL, only the better of the two runs will be taken into account.

Article 9 : Dispute or claim

Any dispute or claim levelled at the organization, or relative to the present rules and regulations, will be brought before the French competent courts, regardless of nationality or the country where initial enrolment was made.

Only the French version of the present rules and regulations shall be authentic.
